**ORDER GRANTING EX PARTE
APPLICATION TO MODIFY
SCHEDULING ORDER [DKT. 111]**

1 On November 14, 2022, Plaintiffs Jasmine Williams, Juwan White, Joseph
2 Nett, and Lakisha Swift (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) filed an Ex Parte Application
3 (“Application”), requesting the court modify the Scheduling Order to extend
4 Plaintiffs’ deadline to file a Motion for Class Certification (“Motion”). Dkt. 111.
5 Defendants have filed a Conditional Opposition, stating they do not oppose the
6 request for a continuance but cannot stipulate to the request because of a pending
7 conflict between Plaintiffs’ counsel and Defendant Dominick Rivetti. Dkt. 113 at 9-
8 10.

9 The court having read and considered the Application and finding good cause
10 therefor, hereby GRANTS the Application and ORDERS as follows:


11 1. The Last Date to Hear Motion for Class Certification, which is currently
12 set for January 6, 2023, shall be extended to June 16, 2023.

13 2. The briefing schedule for Plaintiffs’ anticipated Motion for Class
14 Certification shall be as follows:

- 15 • Plaintiffs’ deadline to file the Motion: March 1, 2023;
- 16 • Defendants’ deadline to file an Opposition to the Motion:
17 April 14, 2023;
- 18 • Plaintiffs’ deadline to file a Reply in support of the Motion:
19 May 5, 2023.
