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**ORDER**

On May 14, 2014, the Court held a hearing on plaintiffs’ motion for a preliminary injunction and the government-defendants’ motion to dismiss. **ORDERED** that plaintiffs’ motion for a preliminary injunction [Dkt. No. 4] is **DENIED AS MOOT**; it is further
