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# **DECLARATION OF ALICE N. ROGOFF**

- I, Alice N. Rogoff, declare and state as follows:
- 1. My name is Alice N. Rogoff. I am the publisher and ultimate owner of Alaska Dispatch News, LLC, ("ADN"), Debtor herein. ADN owns and operates Alaska's largest newspaper and an online news site. The newspaper, or its predecessor, was originally founded in 1946 and has been published in Anchorage for over 70 years.
- 2. My professional background is as follows. I graduated from Connecticut College, and in 1978 received an MBA degree from Harvard Business School. For over ten years I served as the Chief Financial Officer for the magazine, US News and World Report. I worked at The Washington Post as an assistant to publisher Donald Graham.
- After several visits to Alaska, I purchased a home in Anchorage, and I committed myself to work on state and local issues, including Alaska Native arts and Arctic issues.

# **Acquisition Background**

- 4. Due to my background in the news business and my strong interest in Alaska, I began looking for an on-line platform to run a news program that featured stories about various Arctic communities that were not often covered by the mainstream press. In 2009, I invested in Alaska Dispatch Publishing, LLC, an online news site. It was my desire to expand the news site, and in late 2013, I contacted The McClatchy Group, the owner of the Anchorage Daily News, to discuss the acquisition of the newspaper.
- 5. Discussions with The McClatchy Group culminated in the purchase of the stock of Anchorage Daily News, Inc.. The closing of the purchase of the stock occurred

on May 5, 2014, by AK Publishing, LLC. My goal was to increase circulation, improve the online news site and increase coverage of state and local issues. After the acquisition the name "Anchorage Daily News, Inc. was changed to Alaska Dispatch News, Inc. Subsequently the company was converted to Alaska Dispatch News, LLC.

- 6. AK Publishing, LLC was formed On March 11, 2014. AK Publishing, LLC was formed for the purpose of acquiring the stock of Anchorage Daily News, Inc. The total purchase price for the McClatchy stock was \$34,000,000, plus assumption of certain liabilities. Simultaneously with the closing, Anchorage Daily News, Inc. sold the real property and building in which the newspaper offices and printing operations were located, to GCI NADC, LLC, a subsidiary of GCI Communications, for \$14,500,000 plus \$500,000 of prepaid advertising. The proceeds of the sale of the building were applied to the purchase of the stock. I personally borrowed \$13,000,000 from Northrim Bank that was contributed as capital to AK Publishing, LLC, and used for the purchase of the stock. The balance of \$6,000,000 was paid from my personal funds, which were also contributed as capital to AK Publishing, LLC.
- 7. As stated above, ADN is owned by AK Publishing, LLC, an Alaska limited liability company. I am the Manager of AK Publishing, LLC. AK Publishing, LLC is owned by The Moon and the Stars, LLC, of which I am the sole owner.
- 8. From the time of the purchase, I was willing to operate ADN at an operating loss to both maintain robust journalism in Alaska, and as an investment in the future of the company. This included purchasing a new primary printing press, new print and online publishing systems, and development of new revenue streams. At the same time, ADN's overall revenue from print declined, reflecting national trends in print

readership and print advertising, and amplified by Alaska's current economic recession. ADN maintained its position as the dominant online news source in Alaska throughout this period (2.6 million total unique users in June), but as readership shifted from print to online platforms, the company has not been able to maintain the same levels of revenue. The company continues to have a viable core, with 4,000 digital-only subscribers since a metered paywall was installed earlier this year. It is one of the few scaled platforms for advertisers in Alaska. But the company requires major restructuring.

- 9. The factors that have substantially contributed to the current financial condition of ADN, which consists of roughly \$125k in weekly losses are as follows:
- a. Print circulation of the newspaper has continually declined since the 2014 purchase, with annual losses of between 7% and 10%. Nationwide the industry is seeing a corresponding 7%-10% decline in print revenues.
- b. In connection with the purchase of ADN in 2015, the building in which ADN's offices and printing operations were located was sold to GCI NADC LLC, and ADN leased portions of the building from GCI. In 2015, ADN moved its administrative offices to the present location at 3150 C Street in Anchorage. However, substantial difficulties were encountered in locating a suitable location for the relocation of the printing operations. As a result, the GCI Lease was extended.
- c. After substantial due diligence, ADN entered into a long term lease with Arctic Partners, LLC, for warehouse property ("Arctic Road Lease"). The Arctic Road Lease required material improvements, some of which were to be made by the landlord and some by ADN. With the expectation that the improvements would be

completed by December 2016, notice of termination of the GCI Lease was provided to GCI, and ADN purchased new printing presses.

- d. Complications and delays were encountered in completing the improvements at the Arctic Road location with substantial cost overruns. Currently the Arctic Road property is not ready for occupancy and the GCI lease has expired, and has resulted in litigation described in paragraph 20.
- 10. Since the purchase of ADN, I have personally financed ADN's operations, cash shortfalls, and capital expenditures. In addition to the Northrim Bank loan, I guaranteed (i) the Arctic Road lease and (ii) certain removal costs related to the GCI Lease. However, personally financing the future operations of ADN in addition to the current personal guarantees is no longer feasible.

15. As stated above, when I purchased the stock of Anchorage Daily News, Inc., I obtained a personal loan in the amount of \$13,000,000 from Northrim Bank to pay a portion of the purchase price. Originally the loan was secured by (i) my membership DECLARATION OF ALICE N. ROGOFF

interest in The Moon and the Stars, LLC, (ii) the membership interest of The Moon and the Stars, LLC in AK Publishing, LLC, and (iii) the membership interest of AK Publishing, LLC. In addition, all payments that I receive from a Marital Settlement Agreement with my husband, David Rubenstein, were directed and paid into my account at Northrim Bank.

- 16. A portion of the loan was paid, and the loan was extended on two occasions, with the last extension in March 2017. The maturity date is September 30, 2017. The amount of the loan is \$10,165,000, plus accrued interest as of July 31, 2017 in the amount of \$81,459.25, and attorneys' fees (through June 30, 2017) of \$11,597.00. Interest at the rate of 6.5% is due monthly. In March 2017, additional security was pledged to Northrim Bank consisting of (i) a security interest in the assets of ADN, (ii) a pledge agreement of the monies received by me from the Marital Settlement Agreement, and (ii) a security interest in my personal investment accounts at Wells Fargo Bank.
- 17. Birket Engineering, Inc. filed a UCC financing statement on August 10, 2017, providing for a lien in the amount of approximately \$160,000 for work performed in the Arctic Road leased space.
- 18. As set out in paragraph 13, health care insurance premiums for ADN employees and dependant plan participants are in arrears for the months of July and August 2017. The monthly premium is approximately \$158,000.00, however the July premium included retroactive calculations and totaled \$204,195.27. On August 3, 2017, ADN executed a promissory note with Premera Blue Cross, with the understanding that in exchange for a partial payment of \$100,000.00, Premera

Blue Cross would keep cancellation of the company sponsored health insurance plan in abeyance through September 15, 2017, at which time the remaining amounts due for insurance premiums for July, August, September 2017, would be paid by ADN. During this period, Premera agreed not to cancel the insurance plan, and to continue pharmacy benefits while holding all other claims until the retroactive premiums are paid. On or about August 9, 2017, ADN remitted a \$100,000.00 payment to Premera. Under the agreement with the Buyer, Buyer has agreed to make the retroactive premium payments due under the promissory note, which would total approximately \$421,000.00, and to continue to the health care insurance plan during the period of reorganization.

- 19. ADN currently has (i) substantial outstanding accounts payable, (ii) substantial penalty rent obligations to GCI, and (iii) lease obligations to Arctic Road Partners. See attached creditor lists.
- 20. On August 11, 2017, GCI filed an eviction lawsuit against the ADN, AK Publishing, LLC and myself. The lawsuit seeks to evict ADN from 1001 Northway Drive, Anchorage, Alaska and claims damages in excess of \$1,000,000.00. The lawsuit asserts that GCI purchased the property in order to acquire the property for GCI's own use, but that it entered into a lease agreement with ADN due to the "significant financial and construction constraints associated with removing the newspaper press from the Building . . . ." The original lease distinguished the warehouse space of the property separately from the office space of the property, with the warehouse space set to expire on November 30, 2015 and the office space to expire on February 28, 2015. The lease allowed for early termination of both the warehouse and office spaces. On October 3, 2014, ADN terminated the office space of the lease and agreed it would expire on

December 15, 2014. The warehouse space of the lease remained unchanged and was still set to expire on November 30, 2015. The early termination of the office space was memorialized in a First Amendment to Lease Agreement dated December 15, 2014.

- 21. ADN remained in the warehouse space after December 15, 2016 and became a month-to-month tenant or a tenant at sufferance. GCI delivered notices of default to ADN dated March 20, 2017, April 21, 2017, July 7, 2017, July 20, 2017 and the Notice to Quit, detailed above, on August 9, 2017.
- 22. As of the date of filing eviction lawsuit, GCI is seeking \$1,390,180.35 in base rent, holdover rent, utilities, fees and interest, plus accrued amounts into the future until GCI obtains possession. GCI seeks damages or an order for the resolution of lien on the property held by Anchorage Sheet Metal, LLC in the amount of \$4,775.00. GCI seeks damages for "removal improvements," including removal of the printing press. Additionally, GCI is claiming consequential damages resulting from being unable to use the property in an amount to be proven at trial. Finally, GCI is seeking to "pierce the corporate veil" and hold me personally liable for the companies' debts and obligations. A court hearing on the right to possession of the property has been set for August 21, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.
- 23. Given the current financial condition of the newspaper and being committed to Alaska's newspaper, I began discussions with potential purchasers and investors.
- 24. A purchase of the assets of ADN will allow for the continued publication of Alaska's largest newspaper, which is vital to all of Alaska. At stake are the livelihoods of employees, contractors and vendors, but also the continuing existence of a deeply

rooted civic institution that plays a critical role in having an informed citizenry and that provides a town square for all Alaskans.

- 25. The company put together a comprehensive information packet for interested parties. The company conducted in-depth due diligence meetings with several highly interested potential purchasers, each of whom has invested considerable resources to visit the company premises, interview key employees, and analyze financials in detail. Two of the potential purchasers have indicated that a process which would provide them with additional time, finality, and freedom from encumbrances would enhance their ability to put together a purchase offer
- 26. Without a sale, there is little choice but to cease ADN's operations to the detriment of its subscribers, employees, advertisers, and the State of Alaska as a whole, due to a shutdown of ADN's print operation:
- a. The company was served on August 10, 2017, with a Notice to Quit from GCI demanding ADN vacate the Northway Drive plant by 10 a.m. on August 11, 2017.
- b. Vacating the Northway plant would mean ceasing printing of the newspaper and would severely compound its current financial situation. The company has no other feasible printing options in the immediate term.
- c. If the print newspaper were discontinued, the company would lose the bulk of its operating revenue. The company could not cover basic operating expenses and would be forced to cease operations.
- d. Stopping production of the print newspaper would also trigger additional liabilities, including but not limited to the need to refund advertisers who have

already paid for future ads that have not been published and have to refund more than \$1 million in prepaid print subscriptions.

## **Proposed Sale**

- 27. Debtor is entering into an Asset Purchase Agreement with Binkley Company, LLC, ("Buyer") under the terms of which Buyer will purchase the assets of ADN. The Buyer is a part of the Binkley Family Companies. The Buyer will be headed by Ryan Binkley and Jason Evans. Mr. Evans is currently the President/CEO of Rural Energy Enterprises and the owner of Financial Inc., a business consulting firm. He is also the owner of Alaska Media LLC which publishes the Arctic Sounder, the Bristol Bay Times, the Dutch Harbor Fisherman, and the Homer Tribune newspapers. Mr. Evans also formerly served as the Chief Operating Officer of Alaska Growth Capital, a subsidiary of Arctic Slope Regional Corporation.
- 28. Ryan Binkley, a shareholder and CEO of the Binkley Family Companies, will lead the Binkley family interests in ADN. A fourth generation Alaskan, he grew up in Bethel and Fairbanks. The family has been in the Alaska river transportation business continuously since then. Ryan has served as CEO of all Binkley Family Companies since 2006.
- 29. On August 12, 2017, shortly before filing this Chapter 11 petition, ADN entered into an *Asset Purchase Agreement* ("APA") with the Buyer covering all of ADN's entire newspaper business. The parties have also entered into a *Debtor-in-Possession Credit Agreement* ("DIP Loan Agreement") under which the Buyer has agreed to extend a loan ("the DIP loan") of up to \$1,000,000. Under that loan agreement, Buyer will lend ADN up \$350,000 during the first week of the Chapter 11, and (provided that the breakup fee described below is approved), Buyer will also advance up to \$200,000 per DECLARATION OF ALICE N. ROGOFF

week thereafter, up to a total loan of \$1,000,000. The first week's funds will be used to address the Premera problem described in paragraph 17 of this Declaration, and the balance of the funds will be used to fund post-petition operations. The DIP Loan Agreement contains a number of other provisions, among them being Section 3.10, which essentially provides that the Binkley Company may, at its sole discretion, stop lending to ADN.

- 30. Under the APA, the purchase price for the business under the APA is \$1,000,000, less whatever is actually due under the DIP Loan Agreement. This means that, if the newspaper is sold to the Binkley Company, all or virtually all of the sale proceeds would go towards repaying the DIP loan, and there would be little or no cash proceeds paid to the bankruptcy estate. Obviously, this is not the outcome I would prefer, but the reason I agreed to these terms is that my primary desire is to see that the newspaper continue in operation. Also, there is a possibility that the final sale price may be higher than \$1 million.
- 31. The APA is subject to bankruptcy court approval, which among other things means under my understanding that if some other buyer wishes to purchase the business for more than \$1 million, then there may be an auction process, supervised by the court, to determine the high bidder. It is possible, under this scenario, that the Binkley Company, LLC, will not be the ultimate buyer, and if that happens then Binkley Company, LLC will be repaid the amount due under the DIP Loan Agreement, and the excess funds would be paid to the bankruptcy estate. In light of this risk, and in order to induce the Binkley Company, LLC to enter into the DIP Loan Agreement, that agreement, at Section 3.03, gives the Binkley Company a "breakup" fee equal to 3% of

the final purchase price, and reimbursement of expenses up to \$100,000. Court approval of this breakup fee is a condition of Buyer making DIP Loan advances for the second and subsequent weeks. Section 2.8 of the APA also gives the Binkley Company the right to install a manager, immediately following the petition date. The Binkley Company has not given me any details on this provision, so I cannot comment further on it.

32. I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Alaska that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

#### (1) Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### (a) Organization

Anchorage Daily News, LLC (the Company) publishes a daily newspaper and related direct marketing and digital products in Anchorage, Alaska. The Company uses the trade name Alaska Dispatch News.

The Alaska Dispatch News began as the weekly Anchorage News, publishing its first issue January 13, 1946. The newspaper became an afternoon daily in May 1948, a morning daily newspaper on April 13, 1964 and published its first Sunday Newspaper in 1965.

In 2014 AK Publishing, LLC (AKP) purchased the stock of Anchorage Daily News, Inc. from McClatchy Newspapers, Inc., made an election under Section 338 of the IRS code, converted Anchorage Daily News, Inc. to an Alaska limited liability company and adopted the trade name.

The Company's fiscal year is the 52 or 53 weeks ending on the last Sunday in December. The fiscal year ended December 27, 2015 was comprised of a 52 week year.

#### (b) Use of accounting estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### (c) Concentration of credit risks

Cash is placed at major financial institutions and at times balances exceed federal insurance limits. Uninsured balances at December 27, 2015 were approximately \$450,000.

We routinely assess the financial strength of significant customers. These assessments and the number and diversity of our customers' limit our concentration of risk with respect to trade accounts receivable.

#### (d) Accounts receivable

Receivables consist primarily of receivables from commercial companies, local and national advertising agencies and government authorities on an unsecured basis. Trade receivables are net of an allowance for doubtful accounts. Management determines the allowance for doubtful accounts based on potential problem accounts and historical experiences as well as the level of aged accounts. Receivables are considered past due when still outstanding after 90 days. Receivables are written off when they are past due, efforts to collect have been exhausted and management determines they are not collectible.

#### (e) Newsprint, ink and other inventories

Newsprint, ink and other inventories are stated at the lower of cost or market, where cost is based on a first-in, first-out usage pattern.

#### (f) Property and equipment

Equipment on hand at the date of purchase is stated at an allocation of the total agreed value based on prior experience with similar assets. Equipment and leasehold improvements purchased subsequent to the purchase are recorded at cost. Additions and substantial improvements as well as labor cost incurred during installation are capitalized. They are depreciated and amortized using straight-line method over the shorter of lease term or estimated life. The estimated life used for equipment is 3 to 20 years. Leasehold improvements are depreciated over the remaining life the lease, including expected extensions. Maintenance and repairs are expensed when incurred.

Depreciation and amortization expense for the 52 week period ended December 27, 2015 was \$894,976 and \$1,302,294, respectively.

## (g) Impairment of long lived assets

Long lived assets and intangibles are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate the carrying amount of an asset may not be recoverable. Recoverability of assets to be held and used is measured by a comparison of the carrying amount of the assets to the future net cash flows expected to be generated by the asset. If such assets are considered to be impaired the impairment to be recognized is measured by the amount by which the carrying value exceeds the fair value of the assets. Assets to be disposed of are reported at the lower of the carrying amount or fair value less the cost to dispose of or sell.

#### (h) Income tax

The Company is a single member limited liability company and as such it does not pay federal or state income taxes. The Company's taxable income or loss is reported by its member. Therefore, no provision or liability for federal income taxes has been included in the financial statements. Liability for all taxes arising prior to the purchase of the stock in 2014 by AKP has been assumed by McClatchy Newspapers, Inc.

Net income for financial purposes may differ significantly from taxable income reportable to its member as a result of differences between the tax basis and financial basis of assets and liabilities.

## (1) Summary of Significant Accounting Policies, continued

#### (i) Revenue recognition

Advertising revenue is recognized over the contract period that advertising is placed in the newspaper, website and/or a mobile service or as services are delivered, as appropriate. Circulation revenue is recognized as newspapers are delivered over the applicable subscription term. Advance payments for subscriptions result in unearned revenue. Commercial printing and other revenues are recognized when the related product or service has been delivered.

#### (i) Goodwill

The Company has adopted FASB Accounting Standards Update No. 2014-02, Intangibles-Goodwill and Other. In accordance with this alternative, the Company amortizes goodwill over ten years on the straight-line basis and only evaluates goodwill for impairment at the entity level when a triggering event occurs.

#### (k) Subsequent events

The Company evaluated subsequent events through May 4, 2016 the date these financial statements were available to be issued. No material events were identified that required adjustment or additional disclosures in these financial statements, except as already adjusted or disclosed.

In 2016 the Company paid approximately \$1,008,000 on contracts of \$1,875,000 to purchase and install a new press and packaging center; which includes transportation and relocation of existing equipment.

#### (3) Change in depreciable lives of printing equipment

Effective December 28, 2014, the Company changed its estimates of the useful lives of printing equipment. The printing equipment's lives were decreased to an average of 5 years from the previous average of 11 years. The Company made these changes to better reflect the estimated periods during which such assets will remain in service. This change had the effect of increasing 2015 depreciation expense by approximately \$280,000 and increasing 2015 net operating loss by \$280,000.

#### (4) Employee Benefit Plan

The Company employees may participate in a 401(k) salary deferral retirement plan. An employee becomes eligible after two months of continuous employment for those employees scheduled for 20 hours or more per week and 1000 hours of service in a plan year for the employees scheduled for less than 20 hours per week after attaining the age of 18. Eligible participants may receive a discretionary matching contribution from the Company. No match has been made for 2015.

#### (5) Barter Transactions

From time to time, the Company engages in advertising barter transactions. The Company's barter transactions are recorded at the estimated fair value of the advertisements provided, based on recent historical cash transactions. Barter revenue is recognized when the advertising services are delivered to the customer, and advertising expense is recorded when the advertising services are received from the customer. For the 52 week period ended December 27, 2015, the Company recognized \$239,811 of advertising revenues and \$239,811 of advertising expenses from barter transactions. Subsequent to December 27, 2015, a vendor forgave \$205,000 of trade accounts payable accrued at December 27, 2015 in exchange for advertising services.

#### (6) Contingencies

The Company was a Guarantor of a \$2,000,000 line of credit loan of its parent, AKP. All Chattel paper, accounts and general intangibles were pledged as collateral. The line of credit matured July 30, 2015, and was not renewed. As of December 27, 2015, the line of credit loan balance was \$0.

In the normal course of business, the Company may be a participant or potential participant in legal proceedings related to the conduct of its business that cannot be predicted with certainty and that will result in contingent liabilities or contingent assets that are not reflected in the accompanying financial statements. In the opinion of management, the financial position or results of operations of the Company will not be materially affected by any current legal proceeding.

#### (7) Leases

The Company leases buildings for office space and printing plant operations. The lease for office space runs to December 31, 2021 with an option to renew for an additional five year term. The current monthly rent is \$49,135 and increases 3% each year plus a pass through of a proportion of operating cost increases. The lease for the operations location expired on December 4, 2015, however subsequent to year end, the lease was retroactively amended to add two 12-month extension periods and the first extension was exercised. The current monthly base rent is \$62,821 and increases 2.5% each year. In addition to the base rent, the Company shall provide specified in-kind advertising during the extension period estimated at \$40,762 per week as well as specified in-kind adverting for a duration of five years estimated at \$995 per week. An alternate location for the printing operation is being evaluated for relocation in 2016.

The Company leases and has subleased out certain warehouse space. The lease and sublease arrangements expired effective April 1, 2016 and will not be renewed. Monthly rent was \$9,853 per month plus utilities. Sublease income was approximately \$10,000 plus utilities monthly.

The Company also leases offices spaces in two other locations which are month to month. Rents in these locations are \$2,250 and \$1,627 per month.

#### (8) Related Party Transactions

During 2015, the Company made payments on behalf of Alaska Dispatch Publishing, LLC, with which it is under common ownership. The receivable from Alaska Dispatch Publishing was \$254,399 at December 27, 2015.

The member of The Moon and The Stars, LLC loaned the Company \$4,574,380 December 27, 2015. Interest accrues at 6% and is payable annually beginning December 27, 2016. Unpaid principal and interest is due and payable on or before December 27, 2025.
