Plaintiff filed her Complaint on October 10, 2023; 22 2. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12 (a)(1)(A)(i), Defendant's original deadline for 23 responding to Plaintiff's Complaint was November 6, 2023; 3. 5	6. Good cause exists to grant the extension because the parties continue to investigate
6	the underlying facts, discuss jurisdictional issues, and explore the possibility of an early resolution,
7	which may obviate the need for a response to the Complaint;
8	7. This motion is not filed for the purpose of delay, and no party will be prejudiced by
9	the granting of this motion; and
10	8. Subject to Court approval, the Parties stipulate and agree that Defendant shall have
11	an extension of time up to and including January 10, 2024 to answer, move or otherwise respond
12	to Plaintiff's Class Action Complaint.
13	WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that this stipulated motion be granted an
14	that Defendant be granted an extension of time up to and including January 10, 2024 to answer,
15	move or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Class Action Complaint.
